Welcome to the first step in creating your dream space! In this short guide we will tell you how to measure your space so that we can plan the space of your dreams!

Tools Required



Pencil (or pen) & paper



Tape measure

Start by measuring floor to ceiling.

Then measure from wall to wall, and from the corners to the doors and windows. If you have more than one window then measure between them.

Note anything that sticks out in your room such as radiators or pipes.

Measure the size of your doors & windows (include the trim!), and the distance from each one to the floor and the corners.

Mark the position and size of any plug sockets switches, drains and other objects.

If your extractor hood is externally vented, make sure to get the position of the outlet.

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Top Tip

If measuring the overall length of the kitchen is proving difficult then break it down.

For example below, measure from the corner to the door, the door width and then from the other edge of the door to the next corner.
